

Practice 2: (1h)

Imagine that you are the parents of Lucy and Charlie. They are going to spend the weekend with their grandparents. You write them a letter telling them that if they behave well, they will be rewarded by using the conditional form as in the example below.

Conditionnel type 1 : If+ S+simple present, S+ simple future

Example

Dear Lucy and Charlie,

Be good for your grandparents this weekend. **If you** are good, **we will buy** you some presents. Don't forget to brush your teeth. **If you don't brush** your teeth, Daddy and **I will eat** the candy. You know how I love chocolate. **If it rains** tomorrow, **Grandma and Grandpa will take** you to a movie. **Grandma won't take** you to a movie **if you don't eat** your dinner. **If you eat** your vegetables, **Grandpa will buy** you popcorn at the movie. **If you are** good this weekend, **you can have** a sleepover with your cousins next weekend. Call us if you need us. **If you call** the hotel, **they will give** you our room number.
